**Republican River Water Conservation District to Hold Quarterly Board Meeting**

The Board of Directors of the Republican River Water Conservation District will be holding their regular quarterly board meeting in Burlington, Colorado. The date, time, and location of the meeting and a summary of the agenda for the meeting are provided below.

**Agenda:** Consider and potentially approve minutes of previous special Board meeting, January 9-10, 2020 and executive session minutes from January 9-10, 2020 meeting. Board President's report, pipeline operator's report and reports from Board committees including a report on the discussion on the water use fee by the Budget committee. The Conservation committee will report on conservation efforts throughout the basin and on a proposal for an RCPP program through NRCS. Receive report by State Engineer Kevin Rein, presentation by Joe Frank and Jim Yahn on SPROWG and Fremont Butte proposal, Receive application for conservation grant funding from Arikaree Ground Water Management District. Receive presentation by Mike Foor from Yuma County Pest District. The Board will also discuss 2020 rates for professional team. Receive an update report on 2019 conservation grant to the Plains Ground Water Management District. Receive updates and reports from the RRWCD's engineer, federal and state lobbyists and legal counsel.

If necessary, the RRWCD Board of Directors will hold an executive session to receive legal advice on legal questions and litigation concerning South Fork water rights; to discuss and determine positions, develop strategies, and instruct negotiators concerning the purchase or lease of water rights; determine positions and instruct negotiators concerning water supply acquisition, receive legal advice on legal questions related to such agreements, contracts and easements, discuss program applications; the Compact Compliance Pipeline, Bonny Reservoir and personnel matters
